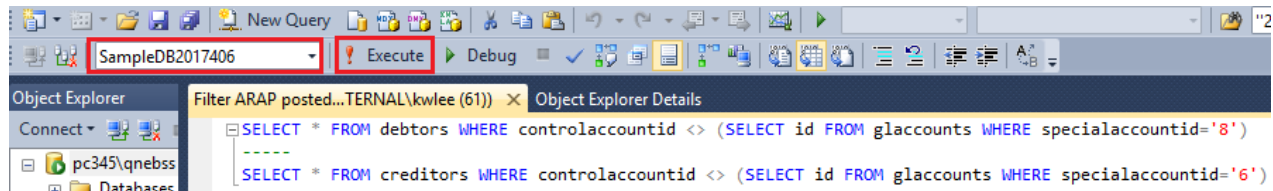
3. Double click on the downloaded script 'Filter ARAP posted to wrong control account.sql'

4. Or copy script from below

```
SELECT * FROM debtors WHERE controlaccountid <> (SELECT id FROM glaccounts WHERE specialaccountid='8')
```

```
SELECT * FROM creditors WHERE controlaccountid <> (SELECT id FROM glaccounts WHERE specialaccountid='6')
```

5. Select the database that wish to Filter ARAP posted to wrong control account



6. Click on Execute button to execute the query.
7. Based on the result, correct the Control Account selection in Customer / Supplier Profile.
